Downloading My Starkey

You must have an Apple ID to download My Starkey. To set up an account, visit https://appleid.apple.com.

- 1 Once an account is set up, open the App Store.
- 2 Search for My Starkey.
- 3 Select **Get**.



Pairing

Pairing should be completed after the hearing aids have been programmed in the Pro Fit software. Ensure that Pro Fit is closed prior to pairing with any Apple device.

- Select Settings > Accessibility > Hearing Devices.
- Ensure Bluetooth® setting is on.
- 3 Power off, then power on the hearing aids to place in pairing mode.
- Select the hearing aids when they appear on the screen.
- 5 When prompted, select **Pair**. You will select Pair twice for a binaural set of hearing aids.
- 6 Ensure it says "Connected" after the hearing aid name.

My Starkey Initial Setup

- 1 Tap on **Get Started** to begin the app set-up process.
- 2 Review the Terms of use. Tap **Accept** to continue.
- 3 Ensure hearing aids are charged and turned on. Select **Continue**.
- 4 A prompt will ask if the user would like to connect to Bluetooth. Select **Ok**. My Starkey will connect to the hearing aids. Select **Continue**.
- Sign in or create an account with an e-mail address and password. **An account is required.** Cloud Connectivity allows for TeleHear, Fall Alert and for app/hearing aid information to be backed up and restored.
- 6 Select **Continue** to allow My Starkey access to the user's location and to share notifications.
- Users are asked to allow My Starkey to send the user notifications. Select **Don't Allow** or **Allow**.
- 8 Users are asked to allow My Starkey to collect and store Hearing aid data, Activity tracking, and Analytics. Select **Allow** or **Not Now.**
- Users are asked to allow My Starkey to send the user Critical Alerts. Select **Don't Allow or Allow.** Selecting **Allow** ensures that a Fall Alert will be presented to the user even if the phone is muted or Do Not Disturb is on.

You're All Set. Select **Got it** to enter My Starkey.
